At 1335, on Monday the 18th of August while conducting Off Shore Law Enforcement Patrols in the Bering Sea, the Cutter MUNRO recieved information from RCC Kodiak of a fishing vessel taking on water, approximately 400 miles southeast in the Bristol Sea.

The fishing vessel THERESA LEE was disabled, adrift with a jammed rudder and taking on water in winds of 60 knots and seas of 20 to 30 feet. The fishing vessel MISS TRACY; although too small to take the TERESA LEE in tow, volunteered to proceed to the disabled craft and stand by until further assistance arrived.

Of the 27 persons aboard the THERESA LEE, 17 were hoisted off the disabled vessel by Helo 1471 dispatched by Air Station Kodiak.
