THE "INDIANA"

Station No.1 rightfully belongs to the INDIANA. She's the oldest boat in the division (commissioned in July, 1942) and is still known to old PD-men as fireboat No.1. Her berth and station now are modern, clean and orderly. But back in '42 her crew had to make their station where they found it. Usually they found it pretty uncomfortable. Fireboat No.1 didn't stay any place very long. She moved from berth 240-A to 145 to 77 to 123 and finally came to rest at berth 118. There her crew had the luxuries of a shower and an eight by eight shack. Included in the furnishings were an electric hot plate. Now she's at berth 44, San Pedro, her permanent home.
