TRAILER UNIT #3 IS ALSO PART OF STATION #1

Trailer Unit No.3 now shares Station No.1 with the crew of the INDIANA. From November, 1942, until April, 1943, T.U.-3 was housed in an old service station in San Pedro at 22nd and Miner streets. When it rained the station leaked water and when the weather cleared, the water stayed inside so well that the boys moved outside so well that the boys moved outside until they could dry up the place. The crew took its first standby on a ship loading high-test gasoline at berth 51. From that point on, T.U.-3's history parallels every other trailer unit in the Fire Division: Explosive standbys, fire calls and long hours of routine work around the station.
