



The T-31 has two Buda diesel pumps, can pump 2,000 gallons of water a minute. She is being loaned to the Coast Guard by the Army for protection of explosive docks.

T-31 AT STATION NO.7

In March of 1945, a new fire fighting unit was added to the division. She is the T-31, a 65-foot, 82-ton Army fireboat. When the Coast Guard took her over, the crew of the CG 30061-F was transferred aboard. She shares Station No.7 with the CG 65018-F and T.U.'s Nos. 5 and 8.
