#### TRAILER UNIT NO. 1

Trailer Unit No. 1 was stationed right in the middle of Patten-Blinn's big lumber yard in Wilmington for the whole war. Recently it has been moved to the south end of the same dock to share the SCANDIA's station at berth No. 198. All of the pictures, however, were taken at the old station. TU-1 was formed in November, 1942, with Russel, Bouslog, Berkline, and Snyder as its original crew. Later Wallace, Powers, Roth, Corey, and Wrigley went to work on the unit. Jones and Baxter replaced some of the men who were pushed out in charge of other units. There is one unique feature about the crew of TU-1: that all the men are specialists.
