Trailer Unit No. 2 was organized in August, 1942, and put in service at berth No. 124 in the San Pedro Lumber Company Yard. At first the crew had no sleeping quarters and had to shift for themselves. Sometimes they slept on lumber piles, when there was any time for sleeping. They stood a phone watch in a pay booth, kept their pumper unit sheltered under a canvas. In a month's time they had built a garage and a small shack. Since then another room has been added, and it has been furnished comfortably by the Red Cross.
