TRAILER UNITS'S NO. 5 AND NO. 8 SHARE STATION NO. 7

At the Navy Landing in Long Beach, the Fire Division has its largest station. There TU's No. 5 and No. 8, their relief crew, and fireboats CG-65018-F and T-31 share the same living quarters. All units answer fire calls in the Army Port of Embarkation area, are hooked into the Long Beach alarm system so that the trailer units can answer calls in city zone No. 2.

Trailer Unit No. 5, the oldest unit at Station No. 7, was quartered with Long Beach Engine Company No. 6 from October, 1942, until June, 1944, when it was moved to the Navy Landing. Its first crew were: Fisher, Wallace, Murry, Goodrick, Thomas, Rasmussen, and Spencer. Trailer Unit No. 8 was formed in April, 1944, and was the first unit on duty at Station No. 7.
