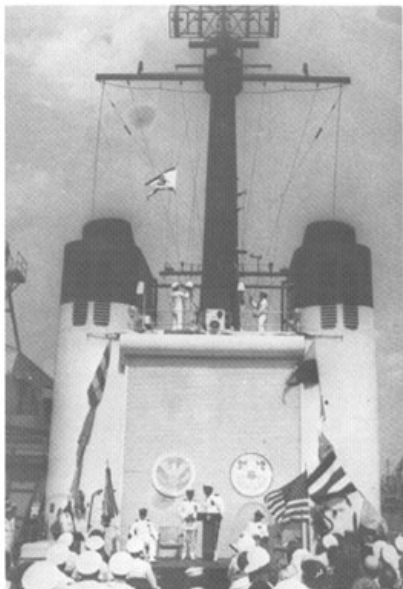


CHANGE OF COMMAND
