

The Crevasse Detector Stalks its Prey:



INCHING AHEAD of trail party, the crevasse detector "feels out" covers, transmits its findings electrically back to receiver (upper). Operator hitches up power cables to transmitter box and adjust bell-shaped detectors (center)

as helicopter stands by for aerial recon. Once found, the crevasse is blasted wide open (below) and its lower limits explored. Spoon-nosed tractors then move in and shove mountains of snow and ice into the holes to fill them.
