

## "Minute Movie" of a Pole Drop:



AIRMEN ride a sledload of equipment for airdrop to the waiting Glibermasters on icestrip two miles away (top). (Center) Soursor keeps pilot posted via interphone on condition of plane's engines; beside him part of load ready to coast along the rollers to drop well; now they drop in pattern formation to waiting ground crew; now they are

retrieved and hauled to camp from drop area. "Soursors" soon trouble, maybe lost to T/Sgt Richard Patten (lower) is briefed by Colonel Crosswell and takes off for the first parachute jump at the South Pole. Safely landed, he guided the planes overhead by means of a combat control radio and helped to lick the drop damage problem.
