A twelve man landing party from the *Eastwind* was sent into Cape Adare by bont to assist the two scientists in moving out. The Coastguardsmen also boarded up the excavated hut to prevent additional interior damage by winter blizzards.

Before leaving, the scientists requested that *Eastwind* be represented in a record book that would be left behind in the hut for future explorers and scientists. The officers and men compiled a page long dedication, part of which went:

*"To those who have braved great hardships here and to those who will continue to do so in the quest for scientific knowledge we say NIL SINE MAGNA LABORE. They have our respect and admiration."*
