

GLACIER embarked 5 members of an Arms Control and Disarmament Agency team at McMurdo Station, Antarctica. The purpose of this team was to inspect 4 stations belonging to other countries to insure their compliance with the various provisions of the Antarctic Treaty. Stations inspected were Base F, Almirante Brown, Presidente Frei, and Bellingshausen. All of the stations were inspected without incident using

GLACIER'S helicopters to transport the team members. On each visit to foreign station, efforts were made to allow GLACIER crewman a chance to visit and also bring station personnel aboard GLACIER. These efforts were successful in all cases. The inspections commenced on 24 January while GLACIER was anchored at Palmer Station and were completed on 28 January at Bellingshausen Station, King George Island.
