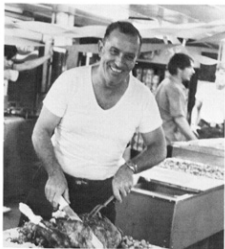


CAPT. BRUCE S. LITTLE, COMMANDING
