Campbell Island Visit.

GLACIER called at Campbell Island on the morning 29 December and anchored out in Perseverance Harbor to off-load re-supply cargo and several scientist. Four hours later 2500 pounds of cargo had been helicopter airlifted to this New Zealand weather station, and mail was delivered to the 20 men who are stationed year round on this remote island. Here the birdlife is observed and a sheep raising study is being conducted to see the effects of sheep on the bird population. A fence across the northwest part keeps the wild sheep on one half of the island.
