

# Introduction

*Three Centuries Under Three Flags* was originally published by the United States Army in 1951, when Governors Island was Headquarters for the First Army. The original text was written by Colonel A.C.M. Azoy, U.S. Army Reserve. This edition has been reissued by the U.S. Coast Guard, Atlantic Area Public Affairs staff.
