

VOYAGE NUMBER TWO

1005 11 May, 1944 unmoored and departed San Francisco, California with 3518 passengers of the Army enroute to Noumea, New Caledonia.

12 - 25 May, 1944 underway as before from San Francisco, California enroute to Noumea, New Caledonia.

1030 26 May, 1944 entered Great Road Bay and at 1215 moored at Pier 7, Nickel Docks, Noumea, New Caledonia.

27-28 May, 1944 disembarked passengers, fueled ship, topped off water tanks and embarked passengers.

0552 29 May, 1944 departed Noumea, New Caledonia with 3524 passengers of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Army Nurse Corps, Navy Nurse Corps, American Red Cross and American civilians, enroute to Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands.

29 - 30 May, 1944 underway as before from Noumea, New Caledonia enroute to Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands.

1731 31 May, 1944 anchored off Lunga Point in Iron Bottom Sound, Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands. Disembarked passengers and discharged cargo.

1015 1 June, 1944 weighed anchor and departed Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands enroute to Russell Islands. 1523 - 1542 have

to in Renard Sound disembarking Naval Officers. 1802 moored to floating dock, Macquitti Bay, Pavuvu Island, Russell Islands. Commenced discharging cargo.

2 June, 1944 engaged in disembarking passenger personnel and in embarking officers and enlisted men of the First Marine Division. 1101 - 1551 returned to Guadalcanal Island and anchored off Luna Point in Iron Bottom Sound. 2025 embarked 32 Japanese Prisoners of War.

3 June, 1944 embarked casualties from Mobile Operating Base Number 8 and loaded mail.

1551 4 June, 1944 departed Guadalcanal Island with 3511 passengers of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, (casuals of the First Division) Coast Guard, Army Nurse Corps, Navy Nurse Corps, American Red Cross, American and New Zealand civilians enroute to San Francisco, California.

5 - 18 June, 1944 underway as before from Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands enroute to San Francisco, California.

0818 19 June, 1944 arrived at San Francisco, California and anchored.

20 June - 5 July, 1944 engaged in disembarking passenger personnel, fueling ship, taking on stores, water and passengers.
