



VOYAGE NUMBER THREE

0800 6 July, 1944 departed San Francisco, California with 3442 passengers of the Army, Navy, American Red Cross and United Service Organizations, enroute to Noumea, New Caledonia.

7 - 20 July, 1944 underway as before from San Francisco, California enroute to Noumea, New Caledonia.

0945 21 July, 1944 entered Great Road Bay and at 1026 moored at Pier 7, Nickel Docks, Noumea, New Caledonia. Disembarked passenger personnel, took on fuel and water and commenced embarking passenger personnel.

1145 22 July, 1944 completed embarking and at 1203 departed Noumea, New Cale-

donia with 1845 passengers of the Army, Navy, American Red Cross, New Zealand Army Cadets, New Zealand Civilians (wives of American Service Men) and Japanese Prisoners of War enroute to San Francisco, California.

23 July - 3 August, 1944 underway as before from Noumea, New Caledonia enroute to San Francisco, California.

1533 4 August, 1944 arrived San Francisco, California and moored at Pier 56.

5 - 11 August, 1944 engaged in disembarking passenger personnel, fueling ship, taking on stores, water and outbound passengers. Ship camouflaged during this inport period.
