

VOYAGE NUMBER FOUR

1753 12 August, 1944 departed San Francisco, California with 3383 passengers of the Navy and civilians enroute to Pearl Harbor, T. H.

13 - 16 August, 1944 underway as before from San Francisco, California enroute to Pearl Harbor, T. H.

1800 17 August, 1944 arrived Pearl Harbor, T. H. and moored at Dock "M", Naval Supply Depot.

18 - 20 August, 1944 disembarked civilian passengers, fueled and embarked Naval personnel.

0921 21 August, 1944 departed Pearl Harbor, T. H. with 3029 passengers of the Navy enroute to Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands.

1425 28 August, 1944 sank a floating mine by gunfire in position 07° 38' South - 177° 15' East.

1228 31 August, 1944 arrived Guadalcanal Island and anchored off Lunga Point in Iron Bottom Sound. 1347 - 1443 shifted to Kukum Dock 1550 - 1750 embarked Army personnel.

1001 1 September, 1944 departed Guadalcanal Island, Solomon Islands enroute to Manus Island, Admiralty Islands.

1032 - 1210 3 September, 1944 hove to in Langemak Bay, New Guinea for routing instructions and then proceeded to Seeadler Harbor, Manus Island, Admiralty Islands arriving and anchoring at 1528 4 September, 1944.

5 - 20 September, 1944 disembarked drafts

of passengers as units of the Third Fleet arrived in Seeadler Harbor.

25 September, 1944 embarked stretcher and ambulatory wounded of the Navy and Marine Corps and Japanese Prisoners of War and at 1300 weighed anchor and departed with 524 passengers for Pearl Harbor, T. H. As ship was standing out of Seeadler Harbor, received a dispatch of commendation from Commander, Task Group 30.9 for work performed at Manus Island.

26 September - 5 October, 1944 underway as before from Seeadler Harbor, Manus Island, Admiralty Islands enroute to Pearl Harbor, T. H.

1623 6 October, 1944 arrived Pearl Harbor, T. H. and moored at Pier A-12.

7 - 8 October, 1944 disembarked Japanese Prisoners of War, embarked passengers and loaded mail.

1517 9 October, 1944 departed Pearl Harbor, T. H. with 894 passengers of the Navy and Marine Corps enroute to San Francisco, California.

10 - 13 underway as before from Pearl Harbor, T. H. enroute to San Francisco, California.

1744 14 October, 1944, arrived San Francisco, California and moored at U. S. Army Pier 7.

15 - 24 October, 1944 engaged in disembarking passenger personnel, fueling ship, taking on stores, water and outbound passengers.
