

VOYAGE NUMBER SIX

0911 16 November, 1944 Captain Richard B. Collman, USN and staff came aboard from Commander, Western Sea Frontier for temporary duty as Convoy Commodore. 0938 departed San Francisco, California with 3371 passengers of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps and civilians enroute to Pearl Harbor, T. H. in company with USS GENERAL S. D. STURGIS (AP-137), USS GENERAL R. E. CALLAN (AP-139), USS GENERAL E. T. COLLINS (AP-147), USS ROCHAMBEAU (AP-63) and S/S CAPE MEARS comprising convoy No. SP-20 (T) escorted by escort vessels USS CONNOLLY (DE-306), USS STERN (DE-187) and USS MARSH (DE-699). Convoy Commodore in the USS GENERAL R. L. HOWZE (AP-134) and that vessel acting as guide.

1140 17 November, 1944 the S/S SEA STAR, S/S SEA FLASHER and S/S PRESIDENT JOHNSON joined the convoy having proceeded to a prearranged rendezvous from Seattle, Washington.

18 - 21 November, 1944 underway as before in convoy from San Francisco, California enroute to Pearl Harbor, T. H.
