1800 22 November, 1944 being bound for Hilo, Hawaii Island, Hawaiian Islands the USS GENERAL R. E. CALLAN (AP-139) and the USS GENERAL E. T. COLLINS (AP-147) left the convoy and proceeded toward their destination accompanied by the USS CONNOLLY (DE-306).

1150 23 November, 1944 arrived Pearl Harbor, T. H. and moored at Pier K-10. 1225-1655 disembarked passenger personnel.

1135 24 November, 1944 Captain Richard B. Coffman, USN and staff departed to report to Commander, Hawaiian Sea Frontier.

0810 - 1000 25 November, 1944 engaged in embarking passenger personnel. 1231 departed Pearl Harbor, T. H. with 50 passengers of the Navy and Coast Guard enroute to San Francisco, California. Accompanied by the escort vessel USS CHEW (DD-106) until 1700.

26 - 29 November, 1944 underway as before from Pearl Harbor, T. H., enroute to San Francisco, California.

2222 30 November, 1944 arrived in San Francisco, California and anchored.

1 - 14 December, 1944 engaged in disembarking passenger personnel, fueling ship, taking on stores, water and outbound passengers.
