acting as escort vessel. Proceeding at 8.9 knots due to the extensively damaged bow of the USS WARHAWK (AP-168), engine-room damage of the USS GILLIGAN (DE-508) and general damage to other ships of the convoy.

27 - 29 January, 1945 underway as before from San Pedro Bay, Leyte Island, Philippine Islands enroute to Manus Island, Admiralty Islands with Manus Section of convoy No. PH-4.

1036 30 January, 1945 changed to convoy formation 18 and entered Seeadler Harbor, Manus Island, Admiralty Islands mooring alongside the tanker USS LEOPARD (IX-122) at 1235. Received dispatch commendation from Commander, Naval Base, Manus Island upon return from Philippine Islands. Departed tanker and anchored at 1633.

1218 - 1450 31 January, 1945 embarked passenger personnel.

0655 - 1045 1 February, 1945 embarked passenger personnel. 1656 departed Seeadler Harbor, Manus Island, Admiralty Islands with 3186 passengers of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, and civilians enroute to Majuro Atoll, Marshall Islands in company with escort vessel USS FOREMAN (DE-633).

2 - 4 February, 1945 underway as before from Seeadler Harbor, Manus Island, Admiralty Islands enroute to Majuro Atoll, Marshall Islands.

1542 5 February, 1945 arrived at Majuro Atoll, Marshall Islands and anchored.

1300 6 February, 1945 embarked 62 passengers of the Marine Corps.

1200 7 February, 1945 departed Majuro
