



The church pennant is hoisted over the national ensign during Divine Services.

Bay, Leyte Island, Philippine Islands with 1152 passengers of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard enroute to Biak, Schouten Islands in company with the escort vessel USS UNDERHILL (DE-682).

1 - 2 June, 1945 underway as before from San Pedro Bay, Leyte Island, Philippine Islands enroute to Biak, Schouten Islands.

0904 3 June, 1945 arrived at Biak, Schouten Islands and anchored in Sorido Lagoon.

4 - 6 June, 1945 embarked stretcher and ambulatory cases and hospital platoons.

0704 - 1007 7 June, 1945 moved to Mios Woendi, New Guinea and went alongside tanker USS VILLA LOBOS (IX-145). 1034 - 1237 embarked stretcher cases. 1308 departed Mios Woendi, New Guinea with 2224 passengers of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps and Coast Guard enroute to San Francisco, California.

1108 8 June, 1945 hove to off Humboldt Bay, Hollandia, New Guinea to transfer ashore the body of a passenger who died of wounds.

9 - 22 June, 1945 underway as before from Mios Woendi, New Guinea enroute to San Francisco, California.

1125 23 June, 1945 arrived San Francisco, California and moored at U. S. Army pier 15.

24 June - 7 July, 1945 engaged in disembarking passengers, fueling ship, taking on stores, water and outbound passengers.
