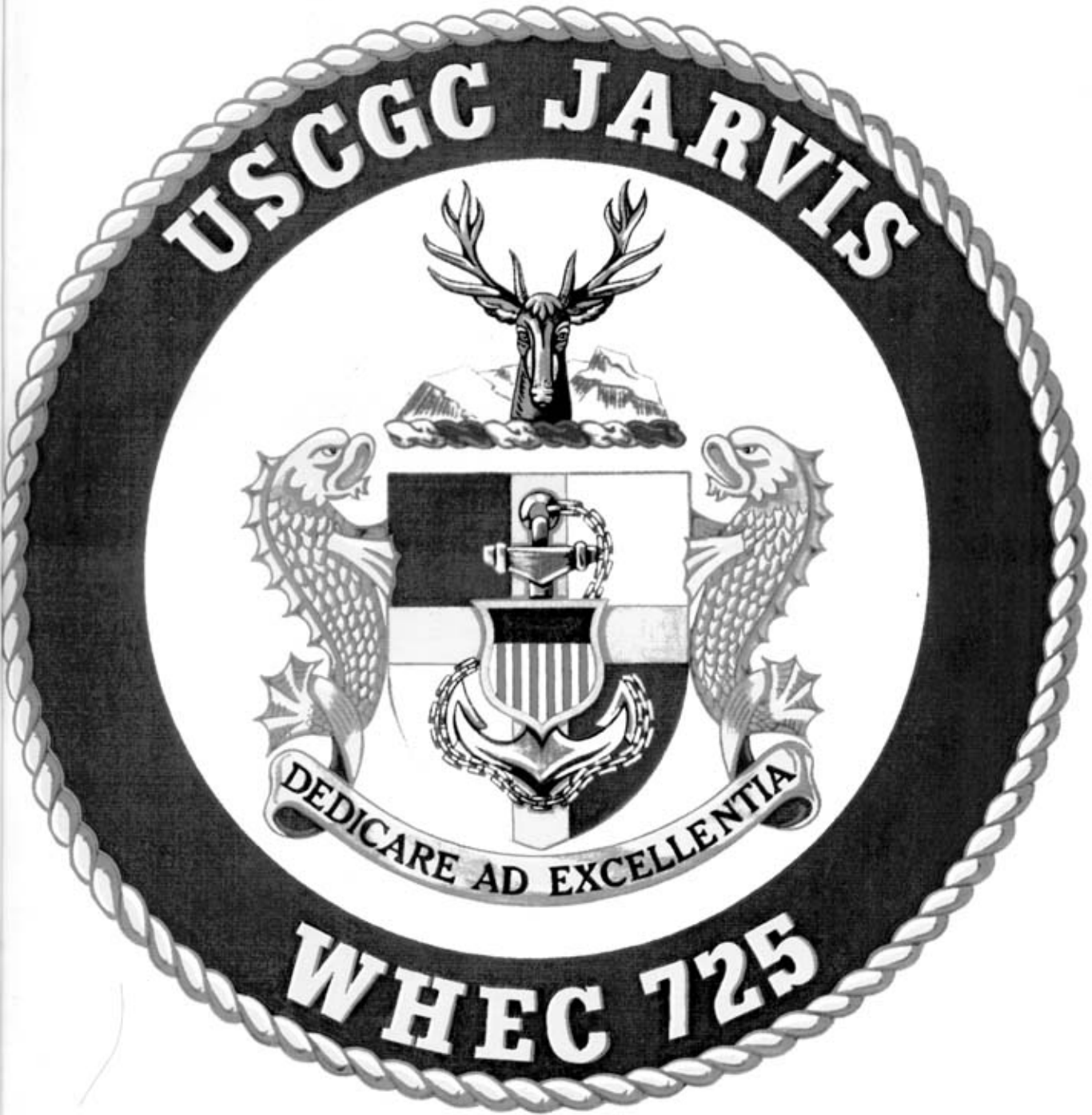


# SHIPBOARD LIFE



COAT OF ARMS

BLUE ALLUDES TO THE SEA AND GOLD IS INDICATIVE OF HONOR, EXCELLENCE AND ACHIEVEMENT. THE BLUE AND GOLD ARE ADAPTED FROM THE RIBBON OF THE MEDAL AWARDED CAPTAIN JARVIS. WHITE STANDS FOR INTEGRITY; THE REINDEER HEAD AND ARCTIC ICEBERG RECALL CAPTAIN JARVIS' FAMOUS OVERLAND EXPEDITION WHILE THE CROSS REPRESENTS THE HUMANITARIAN EFFORT TO SAVE THE STRANDED WHALERS AT BARROW POINT, ALASKA. THE CROSS IS DIVIDED INTO FOUR SECTIONS CHARACTERIZING THE SHIP'S MISSION AREAS. THE ANCHOR, A SYMBOL OF SEA POWER AND MARITIME SERVICE, AND SHIELD WERE ADAPTED FROM THE U.S. COAST GUARD SEAL. THE DOLPHINS SYMBOLIZE LIFESAVING, SEARCH AND RESCUE.
