LCDR. Hugh L. Murphy was born on May 13, 1933 in Brooklyn, New York. He attended George Town University, Washington, D.C. and in October 1954 entered Officers Candidate School.

Mr. Murphy's first assignment came as a Deck Watch Officer aboard the CGC GENTIAN. His first command came as CO of CG Loran Station, Oshima.
