



## Bremmerhaven, Germany

Bremmerhaven lies on the north coast of Germany where the Weser River flows into the North Sea. It is a bustling seaport and one of Europe's busiest. The city has a population of 138,000 and is 30 miles north of Bremen, the largest city in the area.

Nearly destroyed during WWII, Bremmerhaven was totally rebuilt and is a very modern city. It is well served by autobahns and railroads which allowed easy access to the rest of Germany, which the crew explored fully.
