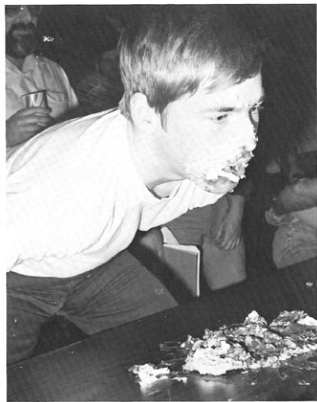
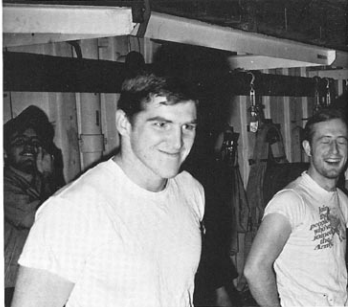


HUMP DAY
