

CHRONOLOGICAL LIST OF MAJOR EVENTS - 1974

- 15 July - Departed Seattle. CHOP to COMPACAREA. Helicopter Detachment No. 49 (HH-52A Numbers 1362 and 1420) aboard.
- 18 July - Entered and CHOP to the 17th Coast Guard District.
- 19 July - Arrived at the USCG Air Station, Women's Bay, Kodiak, Alaska.
- 21 July - Underway, enroute Nome, Alaska, on Phase I.
- 23 July - Passed through Unimak Pass into the Bering Sea.
- 24 July - Anchored in Kuskokwim Bay, position 59-20N, 163-11.5W.
- 25 July - Anchored, southern entrance to Etolin Strait, position 59-48N, 163-35W.
- 26 July - Anchored off Cape Etolin, position 60-30N, 166-28W.
- 27 July - Underway, enroute Norton Sound to assist the Barge Yukon Delta.
- 28 July - Relieved the S/S NORTH STAR III of the Barge Yukon Delta, underway enroute St. Michael with the Yukon Delta in tow.
- 29 July - Anchored off Egg Island in position 63-38.8N, 161-44W with Barge Yukon Delta.
- 30 July - LCM's from Emmonak took Barge Yukon Delta in tow. Underway enroute Norton Bay. Anchored Norton Bay. Underway, enroute Yukon River Delta.
- 31 July - Anchored in position 63-07.5N, 165-18W. Underway, enroute Scammon Bay.
- 1 Aug - Anchored off Cape Romanzoff, position 61-41N, 166-26W. Underway enroute Nome, Alaska.
- 2 Aug - Anchored in Norton Sound off Nome, Alaska.
- 5 Aug - Underway on Phase II, enroute Point Barrow, Alaska. Sighted Cape Dezhneva, Siberia.
- 6 Aug - Entered Chukchi Sea. Crossed International Dateline and Arctic Circle at 66-33N, 168-58W.
- 7 Aug - Held initiation for crossing Arctic Circle. Phase II, 7 stations.
