



Our volunteer's one day's work in Song Ong Doc was not easy. The day spent there was no holiday. As with much of the construction work done in Vietnam, one has to do with what one has. In many of the remote areas mechanized construction equipment and materials has to be air-lifted to the construction site.



In our case, we fabricated most of the materials from scraps we had on board. Several fifty gallon drums were used as reservoir tanks, and an old pump was used to supply the water for the showers.
