

- December 9** WAKEFIELD moored at New Basin, Capetown, and departed the 13th.
- December 27** WAKEFIELD docked in Bombay, India, and passengers started disembarking the next day.
- 1942**
- January 24** WAKEFIELD sailed from Bombay for Singapore with troops.
- January 29** WAKEFIELD docked at Keppel Harbor, Singapore.
- January 30** WAKEFIELD at 1105 sustained a direct bomb hit which killed 5 men and injured 9, started fires which caused considerable damage. Evacuees started coming on board at 1400. The ship sailed in late afternoon, and burial services were held for the five men killed that morning.
- January 31** WAKEFIELD anchored at Batavia, Java, and departed in later afternoon.
- February 7** WAKEFIELD anchored in Colombo, Ceylon, and discharged evacuees.
- February 9** WAKEFIELD departed from Colombo for Bombay.
- February 10** WAKEFIELD anchored in Bombay, and dockyard workmen repaired bomb damage.
- February 20** WAKEFIELD sailed, after evacuees and mail were taken on board for transportation, via Capetown, for New York.
- March 17** WAKEFIELD docked in Brooklyn and discharged passengers.
- March 27** WAKEFIELD arrived at Philadelphia Navy Yard for repairs and reconstruction.
- May 13** WAKEFIELD docked at Norfolk and took on board U. S. Marine Corps personnel, getting under way on the 20th.
