

- May 25** WAKEFIELD docked at Cristobol, Panama.
- June 14** WAKEFIELD docked at Wellington, New Zealand, and the Marines were landed; she got under way with passengers and mail the 21st for New York, via the Panama Canal.
- July 11** WAKEFIELD arrived at Brooklyn pier and discharged passengers.
- August 5** WAKEFIELD in convoy helped transport the largest number of troops to date ever ferried across the Atlantic in a single operation, to Greenock, Scotland.
- September 3** Fire broke out on the WAKEFIELD on her return trip from Scotland, practically demolishing the ship, but all 1,600 passengers and crew were rescued.
